DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

The Companion Events Department is excited to announce our **third** Juniors Agility Competition in conjunction with the AKC Agility Invitational to be held at the Orange County Convention Center in Orlando, Florida. Competition will be held **Friday**, **December 13**, **2013**.

- Entry Limitations Limited to 100 dogs (2 dogs maximum per junior handler)
 - O Entries will open Monday, July 22, 2013 @ 8:30 am EST
 - O Entries will close Monday, September 30, 2013 @ 8:00 am EST
 - Wait list will be kept until Monday, September 30, 2013
- Entry Fees \$25.00 for Juniors Agility Competition; \$10.00 for Time-2-Beat (reduced fee for juniors)
- Junior Eligibility Requirements
 - Competitor must have an AKC Junior Handler number prior to entering. Junior Handler numbers can be requested at <u>http://www.akc.org/kids_juniors/jrnoform.cfm</u>.
 - o For dogs without an agility title from AKC or any recognized agility organization they will need to have a Competition Ready form signed by their trainer that confirms the dog is able to perform all obstacles safely and off leash. 4-H Members who do not have an AKC title or a title from any recognized agility organization on their dogs must have a Competition Ready form signed by their project or club leader who works with the member and their dog to confirm they are ready for competition.
 - The dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a permanent member of the Junior Handler's household. According to the Junior Showmanship Regulations, Section 7. Eligibility of Dog.
 - Handlers must be <u>under 18 years of age</u> on the day of the competition.
 - Eligibility of Dogs
 - o All dogs must:
 - Be a minimum of 15 months old on the day of competition
 - Have an AKC Number or
 - Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) <u>http://www.akc.org/reg/ilpex.cfm</u> or
 - Foreign registration number and country for an unregistered imported dog
 - Identification number issued by AKC
 - AKC Canine Partnerssm Program Listing Number. The AKC Canine Partnerssm Program is for all dogs, including mixed-breed dogs. Any dogs enrolling with the AKC Canine Partnerssm Program to compete at this event will have their \$35 registration fee waived. To enroll a dog please contact Penny Leigh, Program Manager AKC Canine Partnerssm Program at pxl@akc.org or 919-816-3749
 - Have an AKC jump height card or they will be measured on Friday morning prior to the competition and will be moved to the correct height class if necessary.

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A twenty-five (\$25) dollar collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.

EXHIBITOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (EXHIBITOR TEE-SHIRT SIZE, ANNOUNCER'S BIO, CRATING)

/VEWThe Exhibitor Additional Information form will be made available online <u>after</u> October 1, 2013. An email will be sent to all entrants when the link is posted.

All entrants will receive a free exhibitor's tee-shirt - unisex sizes. One tee-shirt per dog entered. Your tee-shirt size must be submitted by Monday, October 7, 2013.

All entrants should submit an announcer's bio. This information will be read during one or more of your dog's run by the announcer. Please include any fun facts that you would like to share, but limit the bio to 30 seconds or less. To assist our announcer at the event, if you or your dog's name is spelled unusually, please spell them out phonetically at the start of your bio to assist us with pronunciation.

The announcer will first read your dog's full registered name, then both owner and handler, followed by your bio – thus you do not need to repeat this information in your bio.

Announcer bio may continue to be submitted until **Wednesday**, **December 11**, **2013**. Exhibitors will be able to enter/edit their own bio while at the show site using the computer workstations provided.

Crating spaces for Juniors will not be pre-assigned.

Each crating space will be approximately 3' x 5'.

A "crate" is defined as having a top, bottom, and 4 walls, all interconnecting, thus preventing the dog from escaping.

Each exhibitor will be required to display an information card on the outside of each crate; card(s) will be supplied in the exhibitor check-in packet.

The information card must have your name and emergency contact information (cell phone# or other). Un-entered dogs will only be allowed in the facility if they can share a crate with an entered dog, or if their crate can be stacked on top or beside that of an entered dog's crate within the assigned 3' x 5' space. No additional crating space may be used for un-entered dogs.

No Ex-Pens will be allowed in the crating area.

Title, bio, and handler updates after this date may be updated <u>by the exhibitor while at the trial site</u> using the computer workstations provided on-site. Please do not email updates after the October 7, 2013 deadline.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The American Kennel Club and the Orange County Convention Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. A full service food concession is available on the site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Dogs may <u>not</u> be on retractable leads or long-lines while inside the buildings at the Orange County Convention Center. No dogs are permitted to be crated or groomed on any carpeted area.

MEASURING & HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured by an **Agility Field Rep** during exhibitor check-in.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles and jumps shall be used pursuant to the latest edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, however, obstacles required by class level may be altered for the event. All classes will take place indoors on a fully-matted surface. There will be three 90' x 100' rings. Electronic timing and rubberized contacts will be used.

Anyone running more than one venue at this event, that has a ring conflict, MUST run during your dog's jump height.

AKC JUNIORS AGILITY COMPETITION - DESCRIPTION & SCORING

- Dogs with an AKC agility title or any titles from a recognized agility organization will compete in the Junior Excellent classes (Standard and Jumpers with Weaves).
 - O Equipment will include:
 - AKC Height A-Frame, Dog Walk & Seesaw
 - 9-12 Weave Poles
 - 8'-9' Closed Tunnel (Chute)
 - Open Tunnel
 - Panel Jump
 - Tire Jump
 - Bar Jump
 - Double Bar Jump
 - Triple Bar Jump
 - Jump Heights will follow AKC Regulations
 - Dogs may enter their appropriate Preferred jump heights. They will be scored within the Regular height. For example, a dog that measures into the 12" class, but enters 8" Preferred will be scored with the 12" class for awards.
- Dogs without any agility titles will compete in the Junior Superior classes (Standard and Jumpers with Weaves).
 - Equipment will include:

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- 5' high A-Frame,
- 3' high Dog Walk
- AKC regulation Seesaw
- 6 Weave Poles
- 8'-9' Closed Tunnel (Chute)
- Open Tunnel
- Panel Jump
- Tire Jump
- Bar Jump
- Double Bar Jump
- O Jump Heights for this class will be as follows:
 - 4" Dogs measuring 8" and under at the withers
 - 8" Dogs measuring 11" and under at the withers
 - 12" Dogs measuring 14" and under at the withers
 - 16"- Dogs measuring 18" and under at the withers
 - 20"- Dogs measuring 22" and under at the withers
 - 24"- Dogs Measuring over 22" at the withers
- Move-Ups
 - Dogs originally entered in Junior Superior, who obtain an AKC agility title or any titles from a recognized agility organization, have the <u>option</u> of moving up to Junior Excellent. This is optional; it is not a requirement. Contact the Trial Secretary at <u>AgilityInvitational@akc.org</u> to request the move-up in writing. Move-up requests must be received by no later than Monday, December 9, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. (Pacific Standard Time).
- Course faults will be scored as follows: Refusal or Run-out = 5 points; Wrong Course = 5 points; Failure (e.g. missed contact or dropped bar) = 5 points; Elimination (obstacle not completed or skipped) = Whistle (score of zero); Course time deductions = 3-point deduction for every second over the course time truncating down to whole numbers.
- The 4-paw safety rule WILL be in effect. Any dog incurring a 4-paw rule violation shall be faulted 5 points and the handler must move on to the next obstacle.
- Obstacles required by class level may be altered for this event.

All dogs entered will be required to jump at the AKC jump height based on the shoulder height of the dog. Any dogs without an official AKC jump height card will be required to be measured during exhibitor check-in. Dogs may not jump lower or higher than their official AKC jump height.

- LEADS. Dogs may not be on retractable leads or long-lines while inside the buildings at the Orange County Convention Center
