Terri Everwine has been involved in the sport of dogs since the age of 12 when she owned an unregistered poodle. She satisfied her desire to show dogs by organizing and running a children's charity dog show with a friend. This charity dog show continued for seven years before the pair acquired registered dogs they could show at AKC events.

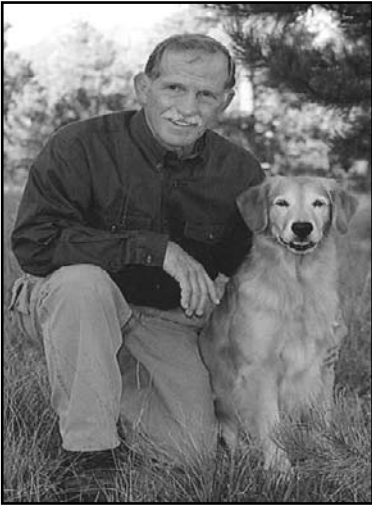
Everwine's interest in obedience and conformation quickly grew to include field trials and tracking. She began tracking in 1979, just before the TDX title was born, with a German Shorthaired Pointer. After earning her TD, she pursued obedience, field trials, and hunt test titles. Soon after, she began judging pointing breed hunt tests.

After attaining Senior and Master Hunter titles on her GSPs, she returned to tracking and earned the TDX on her original GSP. She also titled her other GSPs and Poodles to their TDs and TDXs.

A friend introduced Everwine to Flat-Coated Retrievers and that relationship enabled her to finish her first CT title. Due to her husband's worsening allergies, the family has switched exclusively to poodles. The poodles that Everwine has owned and/or bred have earned titles in conformation, tracking, obedience, rally, agility, and even herding. Last year, Everwine finished her second CT, this time with an owner bred and handled Miniature Poodle.

Everwine currently teaches tracking classes for both Rand Park Dog Training Club and Moraine Tracking club, and she has helped many others earn tracking titles over the years. She began judging tracking tests in 1991. She is honored to have been asked to judge at this year's National Tracking Invitational.

Lewis is the author of *VST – A Journey Worth Pursuing*. All proceeds of the book go to the Golden Retriever Club of America's cancer research.

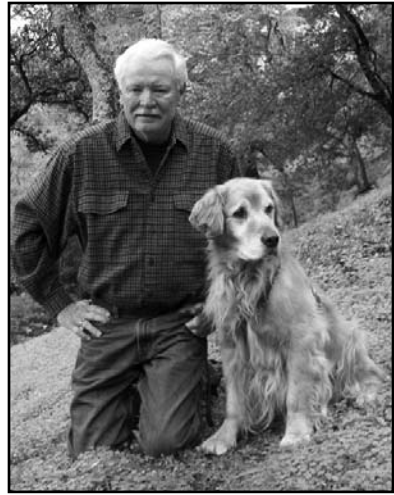

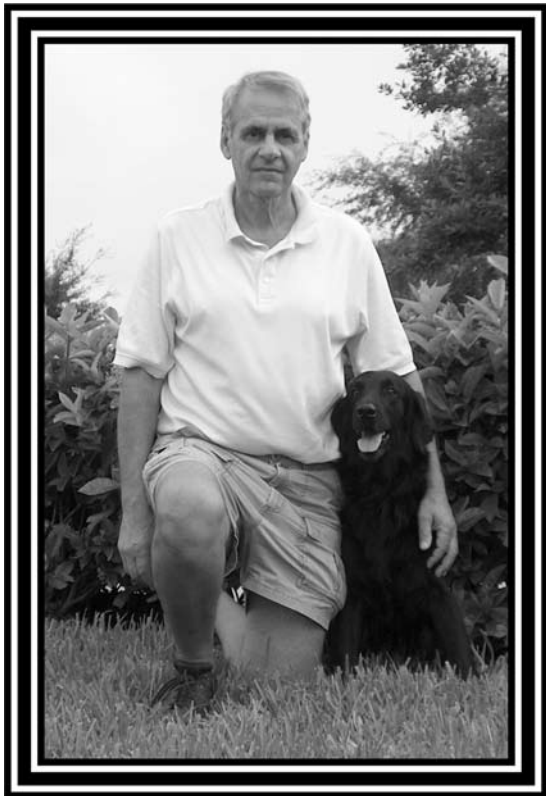

Bella passed her next TDX test in short order.

VST tests are much more difficult since the terrain is urban and many people walk on the grounds. Bella's main problem was her handler, me, the DOPE-ON-A-ROPE. I had a lot to learn about scent pools, patience to allow the dog to sort out and reading her body language for confidence.

When Bella earned her CT, she never hesitated and finished in style. Bella is a once in a lifetime dog and I feel blessed to be owned by her, thanks to Hans and Margarita Berin in Saskatoon, SK, Canada her breeder.

“OBI”

I've had Dachshunds since 1998, mostly field trialing them. The breed can be trying at times because there is always a scent to follow. Obi was given to me by a local family in November 2001. Due to the fact I was getting field titles on my other dogs at the time, Obi and I did not do much together.

In 2005, while accomplishing the field titles, I turned to Obi's tracking career strictly by accident. I had put a track in for Saphy, using flags to mark the turns. Obi slipped out of the pen while I was trying to get Saphy and ran to the backfield where her track was located.

I did not go after him but watched from a distance. My first thought was, "he's messing up Saphy's track." All of a sudden, he overshot that first turn and circled around to pick up the second leg, and to my surprise, I realized Obi knew what he was doing. He went from the start flag to the end flag all by himself and followed my steps back out. Obi would track beautifully, but he didn't indicate the articles so I decided to give him a month off and try again. I got the same results so I decided to do something my tracking coach, Billie French, advised against, and I put food inside the article so Obi would have to work for his reward. The next time I tracked, one of my cats started approaching the article and Obi rushed to get his treat; from this point on, the problem was solved.

Obi's career was put on hold shortly after this event due to a dogfight over a bone. He resumed tracking in mid 2006 and received his TD even while bumping into a nest of bunnies 1 ½ legs near the end. A year later, he got his VST and later his TDX. The day we got the TDX, I almost failed him again by thinking too much. He immediately started out in the correct direction, but I thought it went in another. Since I was not going to follow him, he goofed around hunting until I remembered Billie's saying "to trust your dog," so I took a deep breath saying, "we can do this - you're the best" and off we went in the direction of his choosing. (Granted, I was expecting the whistle to blow that entire first leg.) When Obi reached the first turn, he looked around at me as if saying, "Now do you believe me?"

Since 2008, Obi and I have been a part of Owenton's Grand Paws Search Dog Team. In June 2009, he received his certification for air scenting and tracking by member Billie French and in August, his cadaver certification by member Patty Petzinger.

Obi is my once in a lifetime dog, but most importantly, he is my best friend.

We enrolled in obedience classes and found that Truman and I really enjoyed training. When told we had potential to show in obedience, I joined our local obedience training club and began to train for competition.

The rest, as they say, is history. At age 7, Truman holds 16 AKC titles. He earned his CD and CDX and started tracking shortly thereafter. In the following 2 years, he finished 3 Rally titles, his TD and TDX in one test each, continued to train for VST, and began training for Agility. By fall of 2007, he completed his Novice Agility titles and his VCD1. In 2008, he finished his Open Agility Titles and his VCD2. In November 2008, on his 3rd try, he passed his VST, thus finishing his CT. This summer, he finished his AXJ and we are working on his AX and Obedience UD.

Truman shares his life with us in the Finger Lakes Region of New York and enjoys hiking in the Adirondacks as well as long daily walks in the woods close to home. In his spare time, he has found numerous cell phones and other lost items for people in our area. He just about lives to track, and we are thrilled to be participating in the NTI.

Ruth is a member of the Dog Obedience Training Club of Rochester New York, Hudson Valley Tracking Club, and the Weimaraner Club of America.

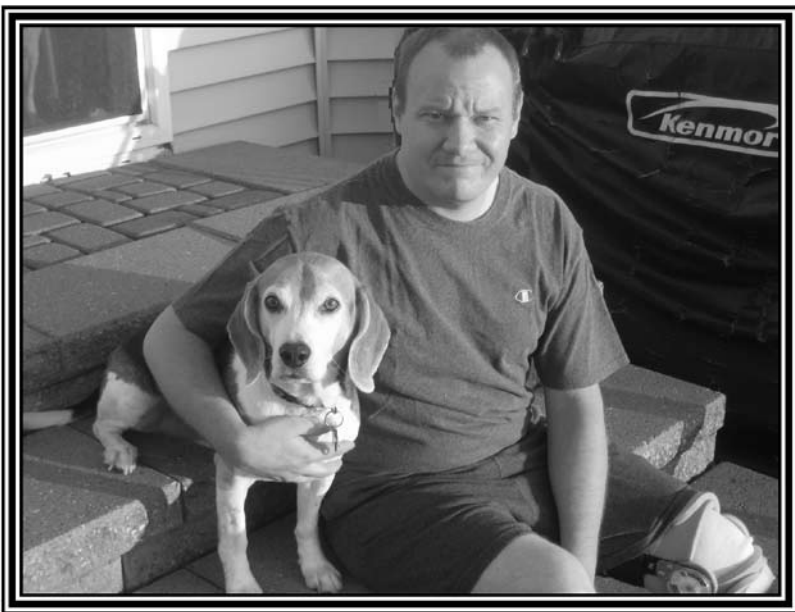

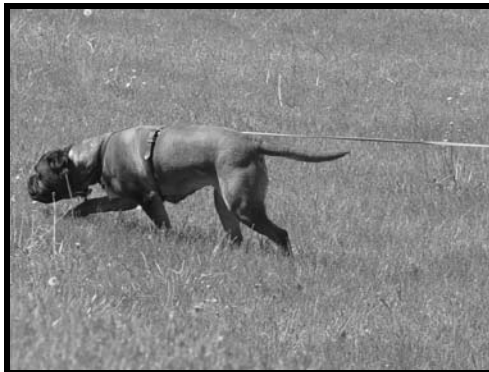

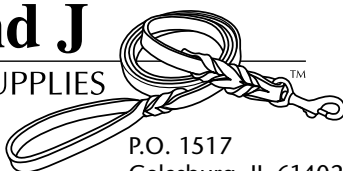
