## QUALIFYING CRITERIA

---

**Due to the 2009 Show being open to all dogs: Those who qualify under any criteria will have an additional year of eligibility.**

**Any dog who appears on any of the qualifying lists will be able to enter in advance of receiving an invite.**

### **QUALIFYING DATES FOR AKC/EUKANUBA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP:**

- October 8, 2009 to October 12, 2010  
October 8, 2008 to October 7, 2009 (2009 eligibility year)
- October 10, 2007 to October 7, 2009 (2 year, BBE/Puppy BBE & Internationals)

### **AUTOMATIC QUALIFIERS**

Dogs automatically qualify for the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship by meeting any one of the following criteria:

- Dogs ranked in the top 25 of their breed (by breed points only) at the end of the qualifying period (1 Year)
- Dogs receiving an all-breed Best in Show at an AKC show held during the qualifying period (1 Year)
- Dogs winning Best of Breed at a parent club national specialty\* (1 Year)
- Dogs completing their Grand Championship during the current qualifying period (1 Year)
- Dogs completing their championship with all points earned from the Amateur-Owner-Handler Class during the current and prior qualifying periods of October 8, 2009 to October 12, 2010.
- Dogs completing their championship with all points earned from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class during the current and prior Qualifying periods of October 10, 2007 to October 7, 2009 (2 Years)
- Dogs earning their championship during the qualifying period with all points earned as a Breeder/Owner/Handler originating from the Puppy Class and/or Bred-By-Exhibitor Class may be eligible for an invitation.
- The seven top breed winning dogs from over 60 International Registries and the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners from Crufts (2 Years)

\* In the event a parent club holds more than one national during the qualifying period, the club will designate which show will "count" as the national specialty for AKC/Eukanuba National Championship purpose.

- Miscellaneous Breeds who have won a CM (Certificate of Merit) or at least 3 Best of Breeds, with competition or 1 Best in Miscellaneous Class with competition.

## **Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Breed, Bred-by-Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show**

### **BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CRITERIA**

- To be eligible for Bred-by-Exhibitor the appropriate box on the entry form must be checked
- All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, except International entries, must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club
- **All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must compete in Best of Breed**
- Dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must be handled throughout the entire breed competition by a breeder/owner of record
- No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition
- Dogs competing in the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show must be handled by a breeder/owner of record

The American Kennel Club Breeder of the Year Award will be bestowed on individuals who best exemplify these time-honored ideals and will recognize people who have dedicated their lives to improving the health, temperament and longevity of purebred dogs.

Recipients will be honored at an awards ceremony during Group Judging on Sunday.

**Breeder of the Year Trophy** - A sterling silver loving cup to be permanently displayed at the Offices of The American Kennel Club, with the recipient's name engraved on a plate on the wooden base. The winner of the Breeder of the Year will receive a 10 inch Sterling Chippendale Tray engraved with their name. **EVERY DOG ENTERED AT THIS EVENT IS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THE BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION IF THE ENTRY IS SHOWN BY A BREEDER-OWNER OF RECORD.**

- **To be eligible for Bred-by-Exhibitor the appropriate box on the entry form must be checked. Dogs so entered will be indicated with an asterisk in the catalog.**
- All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, except International entries, entered under an acceptable individual foreign registration number, must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club
- **All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must compete in the Best of Breed Competition.**
- Dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must be handled throughout the entire breed competition by a breeder/owner of record
- No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition
- Dogs competing in the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show must be handled by a breeder/owner of record

## JUDGING SEQUENCE

- BOB
- BOS
- Awards of Excellence. These awards (between 1 and 5 depending on the number of dogs in competition) are presented in descending order, i.e., first Award of Excellence, second Award of Excellence, etc. All dogs in competition for Best of Breed except the dogs awarded BOB and BOS are eligible for Awards of Excellence

## Judging of Best Bred-By-Exhibitor.

- Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Breed will be selected from those eligible dogs competing in the Best of Breed Class.
- Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. The highest placing eligible dog that competed for BOB is the Best Bred-by Exhibitor
- If the BOB is eligible for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, it is the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor
- If the BOS is eligible, but the BOB is not, the BOS competes against the highest placed eligible Award of Excellence Winner if that dog is of the other sex. If all eligible Award of Excellence winners are of the same sex as the BOS, the BOS is awarded Best Bred-by Exhibitor.
- If neither the BOB nor the BOS winner is eligible, the highest placed eligible Award of Excellence entry is the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor
- If the BOB, the BOS, and all Award of Excellence winners are not eligible, all eligible dogs that competed for BOB compete for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor.
- Prior to the judge making the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Award, the steward must verify that the handler is also an owner and the breeder.
