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PROCEDURE FOR THE FORMULATION AND SUBMISSION OF JUDGING PANELS

Submit judging panel not later than 18 weeks prior to the closing date of entries for the event (Rules Applying to Dog Show, Chapter 4, Section 1);

- You may submit the Judges panel using AKC's Online Event Management System, visit www.akc.org;
 - Or submit this form as an email attachment to eventplans@akc.org
 - Or submit this form the American Kennel Club, PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051; Fax number 919-816-4220.
 - **Before submitting this form, you must have in your possession a breed specific signed agreement from each judge listed herein, that expressly accepts the entire assignment listed for that judge on this form (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 4, Section 1).** The AKC reserves the right to request to see the individual judges signed agreement for any or all judges on this panel.
1. Consult the AKC's *Judges Directory*; draw up a proposed list of judges. The AKC suggests that you work together with the Superintendent or Trial Secretary. Take great care in estimating the number of dogs a judge's assignment, so that the problems resulting from overloads can be minimized.
 2. If the entry for any Obedience judge exceeds the Obedience limits, see the *Obedience Regulations*, Chapter 1, Sections 26 through 29, for the explanation of entry reassignment.
 3. Write to judges setting forth the judge's entire assignment. Remember that agreements must be Breed and/or class specific.
 4. With the exception of Canadian judges, all judges must be eligible for the entire assignment listed in the proposed panel on the date the panel is submitted to AKC. Judges who are in the process of being considered for additional classes by the Board of Directors may not be assigned a class(es) for which they are applying.

NOTE: All approved judging panels will be published in the Events Calendar at least ONCE if the panel is received by the Show Operations Department at least five months prior to the show date. The publication of judging panels has proved very helpful to exhibitors who do not receive premium lists for an event. Also, publication of the panel in the Events Calendar will help your club realize the largest possible entry. To be published, a panel must be processed by the deadline for the publication of the particular issue.

PROPOSED LIST OF JUDGES

For Canadian judges, the complete address must be included. In order to avoid delays in approving your panel, it is strongly suggested that you ascertain the eligibility of ALL Canadian judges prior to submitting your panel. **A Canadian judge who has never judged a requested Obedience class (es) at an AKC event will not be approved if the request has not been submitted to the Judges Operations Department six (6) months prior to the trial date.** If a Canadian judge is approved or denied, **it is your club's responsibility to so inform the judge.**

Please list all Proposed Judges below in alphabetical order, together with their official AKC Judge's number. List each name in the sequence last name, first name, middle initial, suffix (Sr., Jr., etc.) if any, and judge's number. Note that it is important to use each judge's name and number exactly as it appears in the published *Judges Directory*, the Judges Directory on the AKC's web page, Provisional Judges List, or on the Secretary's Page of the *AKC Gazette*. Judges' numbers can be obtained in these publications or by contacting the Judges or Show Operations Departments. Additional Judges may be listed on 8¹/₂" x 11" sheets or on a copy of this form.
