

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

My dog doesn't have any type of number. What should I do? To earn official AKC titles, including tricks, your dog needs one of these numbers: 1) AKC registration number
(https://www.akc.org/register/information/) that usually comes from a breeder, 2) PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing) for purebred dogs (http://images.akc.org/pdf/ADPAL1.pdf?

 3) an AKC Canine Partners number for purebreds and mixed breeds

2. Can I send in for more than one title at a time? Yes, you can send for multiple titles in the same envelope or online. AKC will process each title 24-hours apart.

THE BEST WAY TO SEND IN YOUR TITLES IS THROUGH THE TITLE APPLICATION PORTAL. YOU CAN TRACK THE TITLES, AND THIS IS FASTER. GO TO: https://www.apps.akc.org/title-application-portal/

- 4. Can my DMWYD titles be counted for AKC Trick Dog titles? No, AKC no longer grandfathers DMWYD Titles.

- 7. Can I take the test for multiple levels of Tricks on the same day? Yes, this is fine as long as the evaluator has time.
- 8. Can I judge dogs that I have helped train? Yes, as an evaluator, you are permitted to judge and verify that the dog performed the tricks.

- 10. What is the fee for a Tricks title? The fee for processing each title is \$30.
