STAKES, SCHEDULE AND ENTRIES

RETRIEVING CHAMPIONSHIP	9:00 a.m. Monday March 27, 2006	\$125
NON-RETRIEVING CHAMPIONSHIP	To follow completion of retrieving stake	\$125

COURSES AND BIRDS

Retrieving Championship—This is a two series stake with a mandatory retrieve required in both series with first chukar shot on course.

The first series is 30 minutes without a bird field.

The second series—for dogs in contention—is a 45 minute without a bird field.

Chukars and quail will be released in both series.

Any dog considered in contention that has not had the opportunity for a retrieve will be given a call back for retrieve the day of their run at the discretion of the judges.

Non-retrieving Championship—One hour course without a birdfield.
Quail released.

All stakes will be judged in accordance with AKC Pointing Breed Gun Dog standards.

- Horseback handling permitted in both stakes, and all horses will be kept at a flat walk.
- Collaring permitted in both stakes.
- Blaze orange must be worn in the Retrieving Championship
- Bitches in season permitted in both stakes.
- All shooting in the Retrieving Championship will be on course by official gunners.

SCRATCH POLICY

Per AKC Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Pointing Breeds—entries will be refunded in full only to dogs that have injury or illness that prevent running in the registered stake or that are deceased prior to running in the registered stake. Conestoga Vizsla Club and the AKC Pointing Breed Championships Association may require an appropriate veterinary certificate.

PRIZES

Specially created trophies to all placed dogs in both championships. Rosettes to all placed dogs in both championships. Belt buckles and jackets to the owners of all placed dogs in both Championships. Tri-Tronics training collar to the winner of each Championship. A rosette to top dog of each Breed in both Championships.

QUALIFICATIONS

Open to all AKC registered pointing breeds that, within the past two years of the closing date, have placed first in any AKC Amateur, Open, or Limited Gun Dog stake or have placed 2nd, 3rd or 4th in any AKC Amateur, Open, or Limited Gun Dog stake with at least 13, 18 or 25 starters respectively. Field Champions and Amateur Field Champions are also qualified to enter. Qualifying stakes do not have to be retrieving stakes.

HORSES

Rental horses will be available on a limited basis. If you would like to rent a horse for a half or whole day or if you only need a brace please contact Arnold Treadway at 410-285-6333.

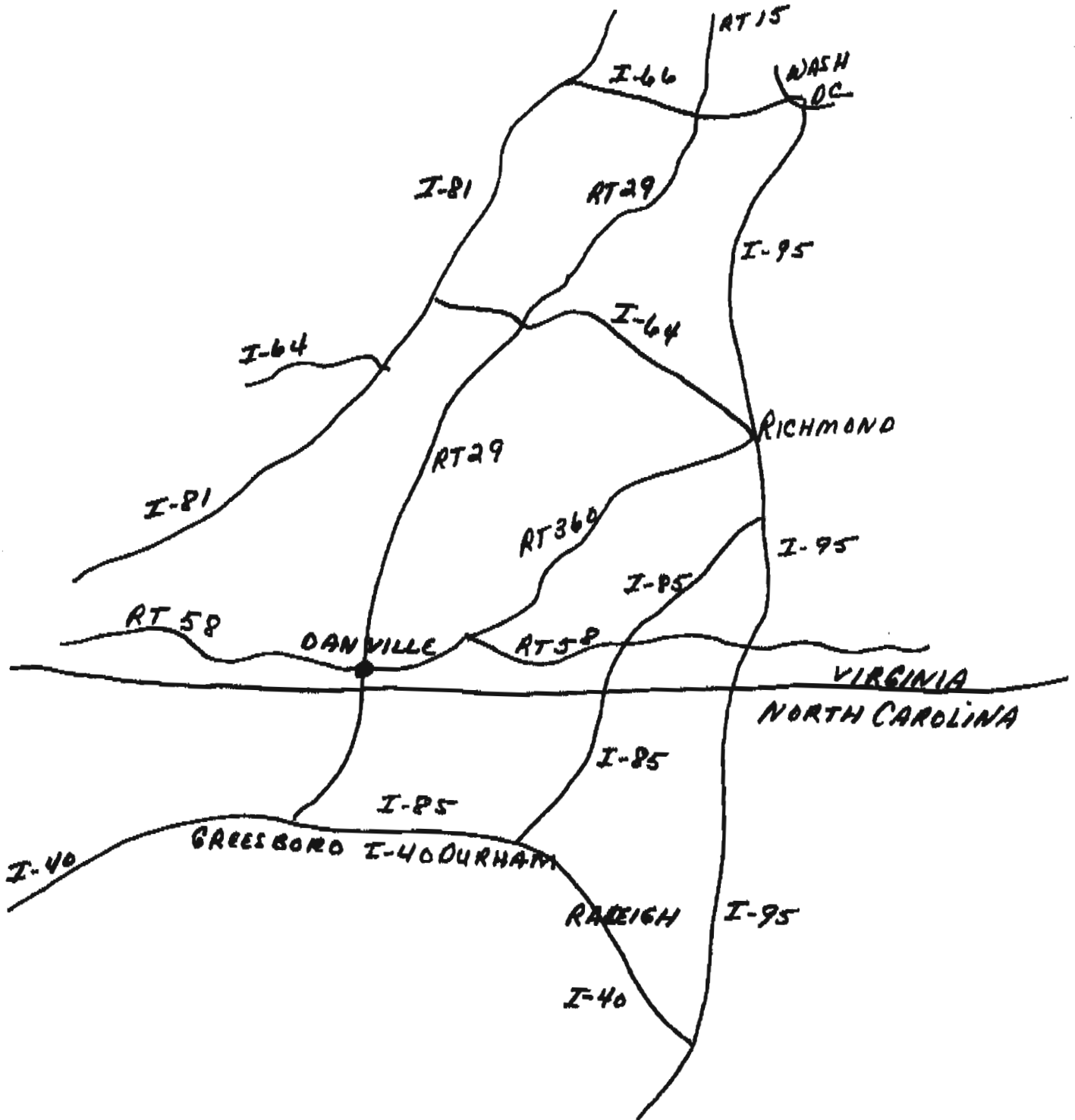

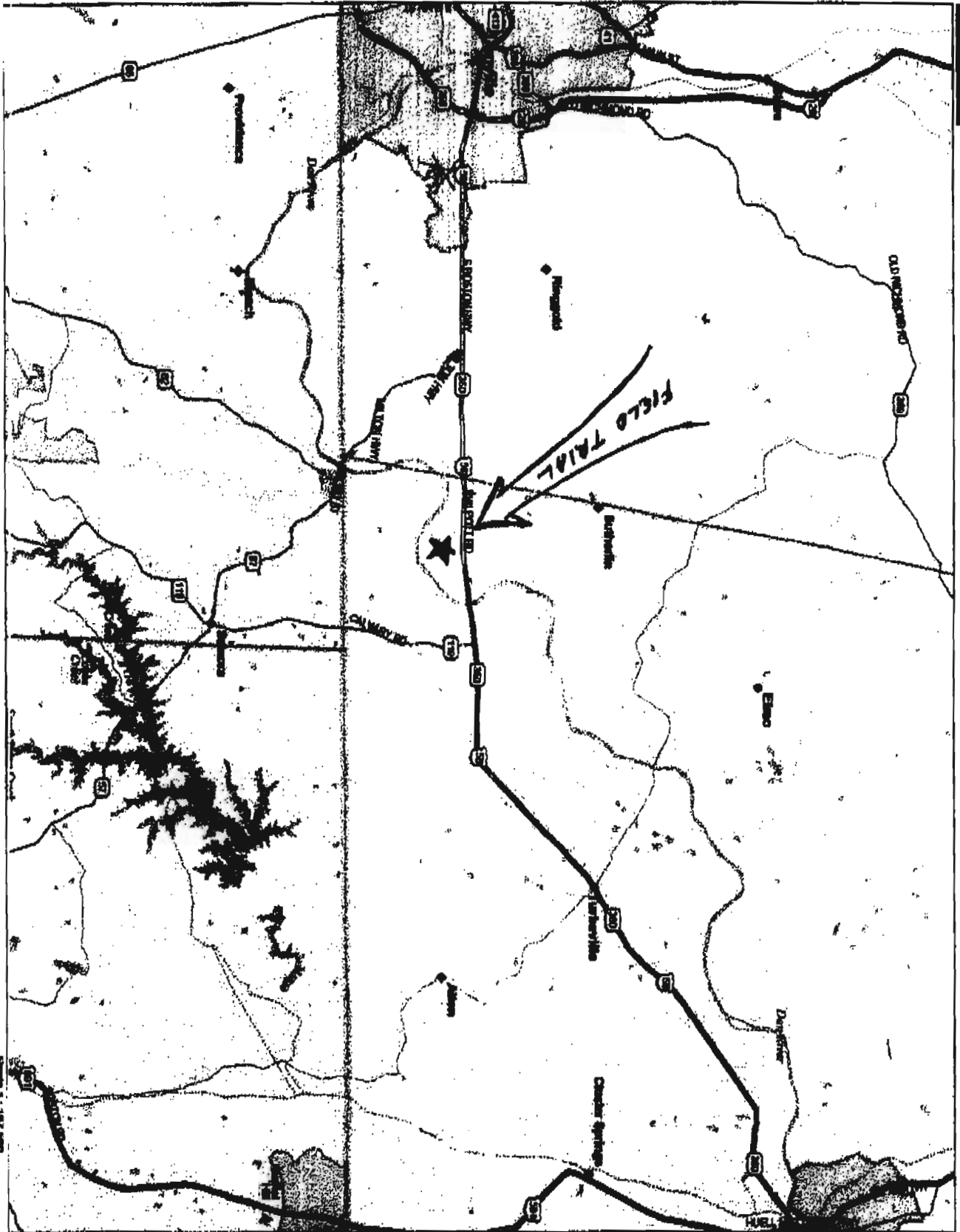


Directions to Field Trial:
