Barn Hunting is a growing sport honoring the traditional terriers used as ratcatchers to rid barns and properties of vermin. The sport of barn hunt tests a dog's instincts without placing any animals in harm. Details on this new sport can be found at [www.barnhunt.com](http://www.barnhunt.com). The sport of barn hunt is open to all dogs, pure or mixed breed, not just terriers.

This event will provide an informal opportunity for you and your dog to experience barn hunting. Our judges for this event will be Judy Todd and Marge Rosa. Be sure to attend the 10:00 briefing by Judy, a licensed barn hunt judge. The briefing will explain barn hunt and its rules to those who are new to the sport, so be sure to arrive early. Practice instinct and novice tests will be run immediately after the briefing.

*Come on out and have fun with your dog! Meet old friends and make new ones. All dogs must be on a secure leash at all times - no flexi/retractable leashes please. You are responsible for your dog's behavior. Please be sure to clean-up after your dog. This event will be held outside rain or shine, so dress accordingly. There are shade trees on site, but come prepared to provide shade and water for your dog. There will be no food vender on site. There is a deli across the street from the firehouse.*

Entry fees are \$10 for the first test entry of each dog and \$5 for each additional test entry for the same dog. Day of clinic entries accepted starting at 9:30, but pre-entering by email to Kathy Hunter at [fionagus2@gmail.com](mailto:fionagus2@gmail.com) would be greatly appreciated (Provide your name, contact info, dog's name, dog's age and tests entered. Minors please have parent/responsible adult submit your entry). **All dogs are required to be vaccinated against rabies. Proof of inoculation must be presented if requested.**

CGC testing will also be available.
