AKC RALLY® JUNIOR SHOWCASE EVENT APPLICATION

AKC Rally® Junior Showcase trial applications and judges' panels must be received by the American Kennel Club at least 18-weeks prior to the closing date of the trial for the club to be in compliance with Chapter 2, Sections 4 & 9 and Chapter 4, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A separate application is required for each trial. Money penalties may be imposed or application may be rejected for noncompliance. A Disaster and Emergency Plan must be available at the event. Trial applications for Junior Showcase events must be done on paper.
