

RALLY - ALL LEVELS

Dear Applicant:

To assist applicants and to prevent people from applying prematurely, we request that you review the following **minimum requirements**. Failure to meet any of the minimum requirements will result in the application being returned.

- 1. Personally owned, trained and titled a dog to an AKC Companion Dog Excellent (CDX) title or a Preferred Companion Dog Excellent (PCDX) title and trained and titled a dog to an AKC Rally Excellent (RE) title.
- 2. Been active in Rally minimum of six (6) years.
- 3. Acted as a steward ten (10) times in the rally classes at AKC member or licensed trials. (Each show/trial will count as only 1 event);
- 4. Acted as a table steward at least three (3) times (This requirement is not in addition to but may be part of the 10 required stewarding assignments);
- 5. Judged an AKC sanctioned rally A or B match a minimum of five (5) times, and apprenticed under three (3) different judges. Apprentice assignments beyond the three (3) required may be used on a one to one basis to replace the match requirement. Apprenticing and Match judging MUST INCLUDE ALL LEVEL classes with a total minimum of 20 dogs per event. - Actively participated as an assistant trainer or as a trainer of rally classes in a dog training club or similar organization;
- 7. Attended an AKC Rally and Obedience seminar within the last three (3) years.
- 8. Provide a current passport photo (head shot) with this application.

All applicants will be required to pass a verbal and written test. This test consists of two parts – Part I (open book) is enclosed along with the application. The answers to these questions are to be returned with your completed application. The answers to the two essay questions will be graded either pass or fail. Part II of the test consists of multiple-choice questions administered by an Obedience/Rally Field Representative and a ringside interview. The test will cover the Rally Regulations, Rules Applying to Dog Shows, and Dealing with Misconduct.

Exemptions from some requirements may be made for applicants in Alaska, Hawaii or Puerto Rico.

After passing the test and interview, applications are referred to the next available meeting of the Companion Events Approval Committee for final determination. Following review, applicants will receive email notification of the Committee's action.

In compliance with the *Rally Judges' Guidelines*, AKC Rally judges must attend at least one obedience and rally judges' seminar presented by AKC staff in every three-year period and will be ineligible to accept assignments if this requirement is not met.

I HEREBY submit my application to the Companion Events Approval Committee of the AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB for its consideration and make the following certifications:

I certify that I am occupationally eligible to judge under AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows and will adhere to the restrictions, if applicable, outlined in the Occupational Eligibility Addendum clarifying Chapter 7, Section 1.

I certify that I am familiar with the American Kennel Club's Rules, Regulations, Policies, Obedience Regulations, Rally Regulations and Rally Judges' Guidelines, and I agree to abide by them.

I certify that if granted provisional or regular judging status, I fully understand that my judging eligibility is conditional and, therefore, reviewable by the AKC Board of Directors at any time subsequent to the date the status was initially granted.

I certify that upon review, AKC's Board of Directors may relieve me of continued judging eligibility.

I certify that I fully understand and stipulate that the committee's authorization to judge on a provisional basis does not guarantee or imply eventual approval as a regular judge.

I certify that I understand and acknowledge that if I am charged with cruelty, inhumane treatment of animals, or similar offense involving inhumane or cruel treatment of dogs, or charged with any crime involving moral turpitude, especially as it concerns dog-related activities, the AKC may temporarily place my judging privileges on referral while the charges are pending. Further, after receiving notification of the referral, I am prevented from judging or from accepting assignments to judge. When the charges are resolved and AKC's inquiry into the matter determines that no action will be taken by the AKC to cause a suspension of my judging privileges, the temporary judging referral will be removed.

I certify that I am a member in good standing with the American Kennel Club, 21 years of age or older, and that all information submitted in this application is truthful and accurate.
