- Any judge assigned an AKC judge's number may judge any breed at 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competitions. (See judges directory at http://www.akc.org/judges_directory/index.cfm)
- The judge assigned to judge the Group will be assumed to judge all breeds within that Group unless otherwise noted.
- Printed breed standards are required to be available.
- The AKC breed standards including the dogs in the Miscellaneous Group are available at the AKC online store. See: http://www.akc.org/store/detail/index.cfm
- FSS Breeds do not have AKC approved breed standards. Breed standards may be available on the breed's parent club website. Additionally, FCI standards can be printed from the FCI website at http://www.fci.be/nomenclature.aspx
- Judging must be informed of all breeds to be assigned to them. Clubs should maintain a record of the judge's written agreement.
