SPECIAL COMPETITIONS

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Breed, Bred-by-Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CRITERIA

- To be eligible for Bred-by-Exhibitor the appropriate box on the entry form must be checked.
- Every dog entered at this event is eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition, if the entry is shown by a breeder-owner of record.
- All dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, except International entries, must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club.
- Dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must be handled throughout the entire breed competition by a breeder/owner of record.
- No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition.
- Dogs competing in the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Groups and Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show must be handled by a breeder/owner of record.

Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group and Best Veteran in Show

Competition is offered for dogs & bitches 7 years & older (divided by sex) entered and exhibited in the veteran classes to compete for Best of Breed Veteran through Best in Show Veteran. Veteran classes will be judged prior to Best of Breed. Veterans that win Best of Breed in the conformation classes are automatically Best of Breed Veteran. **Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are not eligible to compete.** Veteran Best of Breed will be judged following the regular classes in each breed, unless determined as noted above. Veteran Variety Groups & Best Veteran in Show will be held.

NOTE: Altered Veterans are not eligible to compete in the Veteran Classes.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of Juniors, the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

The following breed may be judged on the table or on a ramp: Cardigan Welsh Corgis.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows.

IF YOU ARRIVE EARLY YOU WILL DIRECTED TO A STAGING AREA NEARBY. YOU CANNOT PARK ON AN ACTIVE ROADWAY.

You have the option to park in the parking lot to secure a parking space near the unloading door. This might be a good option to waiting on an unloading line. The parking lot is adjacent to the North/South Building.

You will need to show ID in order to enter the unloading areas. The entry gate is controlled by the OCCC facility; they will restrict the number of vehicles as needed. It's imperative that you unload with speed so others can get in behind you. You will have 20 minutes to unload your vehicle. All vehicles will be required to turn off their engines and leave the flashers on. There will be show personnel and uniformed security to supervise this area. Please note Monday is considered as a "set-up" day for the facility and there is a local law that restricts any children from being in the building during the set-up of any event. Please do not bring children into the building on Monday. This does not include a junior showmanship exhibitor that is entered and accompanied by a parent or quardian.

"EUKANUBA SPECIAL EXHIBITOR SERVICE"

Eukanuba is offering complimentary unloading assistance for exhibitors on Friday, Saturday and Sunday for help in unloading and/or finding a grooming space. Additional information on this service will be provided to those entered.

GROOMING AREAS

All grooming will be indoors. Overnight air conditioning will be provided for the grooming hall Monday through Sunday.

Overnight security will be provided. Building hours are 6:00 am to 11:00 pm.

There is very limited amount of space for chairs in the grooming area.

Grooming and crating areas will be supervised by "Kiarry Site Control" and "The Crew" who will be present to assist in the grooming areas. Anyone who refuses to cooperate with the staff of either company will be subject to disciplinary action.

INFORMATION ON THE OPEN AND ASSIGNED GROOMING PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!!

There will be one **Grooming Area** specifically dedicated for ALL crating and grooming, occupying over 140,000 square feet. This will be the only location where grooming will be permitted.

The Grooming Area will be overseen by Harry Miller and the Kiarry Site Control Staff. Please reach out to Harry's staff if any problems or issues arise. Only his staff will have contact with the facility if needed. No exhibitors are authorized to make requests of the facility and could be held responsible for any costs related to a request that is not approved by Harry's staff.

Assigned Spaces

Those with four or more entries may secure an assigned 80 square foot space (8'x10') that can be set up to your personal specifications. There is a maximum limit of two assigned spaces per exhibitor which must follow the four dogs minimum. We cannot honor special requests to be placed in or next to any specific area or person(s). There will be a special "check-in" desk staffed by Kiarry Site Control where your assigned space number will be confirmed.

Each assigned 8' x 10' space will be provided with a complimentary 2,000 watt electric outlet with exclusive use. Also included will be a catalog page dedicated to those in assigned spaces with their location number. There will be an administrative fee of \$150.00 per assigned space for the entire duration of the events.

Please note: The cutoff date for these assigned spaces is November 11, 2015 or when the available assigned limit is reached, whichever comes first. Any forms received without entries will NOT be processed. Please prepare to enter early as the limit of spaces was reached before closing last year.

"Open Grooming"

This area will strictly follow a set grid for "Crates/Tables/Aisles" without exception. This is a requirement to maintain access for exhibitor and spectators in this area. Complimentary shared electric outlets will be placed throughout this area and no one person may claim exclusive use of this service.

The Open Grooming areas will be arranged in "Rows & Aisles" to facilitate exhibitor space and ensuring a safe and smooth operation of the event. These areas are under strict enforcement of the Fire Marshals' Regulations.

ALL CRATES AND TACK UNITS MUST BE STACKED IN THE OPEN GROOMING AREAS

"Junior Showmanship Only"

There is a reserved section located close to the Junior judging rings and the only dogs in this section are those dogs owned and exhibited by a competing Junior Handler and their family or guardian. No other exhibitors or handlers will be allowed to set up in this section.

NO DOGS MAY BE KEPT OVERNIGHT IN THIS SECTION

"Working Members of the Orlando Cluster"

This area is restricted to those members of the three cluster clubs that might also be exhibiting or have dogs for Meet the Breeds. This area will be monitored by the Orlando Cluster to insure proper use of the area.

By entering this show, the exhibitors and handlers agree to follow all directions of these assistants charged with arranging and maintaining safe and orderly conditions in the grooming areas.

There will be no saving of space under any circumstance. No floor rugs are permitted. Grooming Tables in excess of 24x36 will be regulated by Harry Miller and Kiarry Site Control. No soft-sided crates allowed in the grooming area. No drop pens can be set up in the grooming area regardless of the use. Any containment equipment (dollies or stroller type carts) used for small dogs must be kept in the crate or table designated space. Not in the aisles.

The grooming areas have 2,000 watt electric outlets every 20-25 feet which are available to all exhibitors as "shared usage". Please take every precaution not to overload these outlets with high heat dryers. Electric at an event is closely monitored by the building Fire Marshall and anyone that attempts to overload the outlets puts the entire event at risk. Any unsafe practices will cause that outlet to be removed from service. We will re-set an outlet once. If you cause it to blow a second time it will be pulled from service for the remainder of the event(s). These outlets are meant for single dryer use ONLY. You will have the option to secure an outlet with more wattage at your own expense. Please take care to have any cords in use off the floor and/or firmly secured to prevent any trip hazards.

Those who want to secure exclusive use of an outlet may do so on-site by contacting Harry Miller. The cost for a 2,000 watt outlet is \$276.00 for the duration of the events.

PLEASE DO NOT OVERLOAD ANY OUTLET UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.

BATHING STATIONS

There will be bathing stations available to bathe dogs. These will be located outside of the grooming area, in dock slip N 38. The Bathing Area is a covered, well lit area in one of the dock slips.

Please exercise care not to walk wet dogs inside the building, to avoid a safety hazard to the public attending the shows. Plan to wheel your wet dogs in a crate or carry them. We thank you in advance to pass this information along to those that will be doing the bathing.

Please consider bathing your dogs at home and only doing "touch ups" at the shows.

PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING DURING EXHIBITING HOURS.

There will be ample indoor and covered outdoor public exercise pens located just outside designated exhibitor entrances. There is a limited amount of grass for private ex-pens located adjacent to the exhibitor's entrances. No other grass area is approved for private ex-pens and any set up will be subject to removal by the grounds committee. No private ex-pens will be permitted to be set up in the building during show hours or on any other area around the facility or hotels. Each hotel will have designated exercise areas for their quests with dogs. You are required to clean up after your own dogs at all times.

Private ex-pens are expected to be properly maintained for short term exercise and not as extended play areas. Any pens not kept clean or properly used will be subject to removal by the grounds committee. Harry's staff will determine the number of ex-pens any one exhibitor or handler can

PLEASE NOTE: The facility sprinkler system will be activated each night between the hours of midnight to 3:00 am to rinse the grounds.

THE SHOW RINGS

Please note: Some rings may be expanded for certain breeds on certain days.

We plan to have All Toy and Terrier Breeds scheduled in one area.

There are "ready ring areas" taped off in yellow at each ring for the dogs about to be shown.

THIS AREA IS RESTRICTED TO ONLY DOGS WAITING FOR THEIR RING TIME OR POSSIBLY WAITING IF A CLASS HAS BEEN DIVIDED.

Special Limited Crate Areas for staging when your breed is being judged will be the blue taped areas near the rings. The Fire Marshall will not allow crates or tables to block any aisles in case of an emergency. This will be strictly enforced. Do not attempt to bring crates or tables for any breeds in advance of 30 minutes before scheduled judging. These areas are just for holding dogs ringside, NOT FOR FULL GROOMING. All allowable equipment must be removed within 15 minutes of the conclusion of your breed judging.

PARKING

The OCCC facility controls the parking lots. We were able to secure a reduced rate of \$10.00 per car each day. Oversized vehicles are charged a higher rate. We have arranged for "In and Out" privileges for the OCCC parking lots, but you should be aware that during peak times you might not get back into the same area you left.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.
