- ◆ Entries must be no larger than 11x17 inches in size.
- ◆ The AKC retains the right to publish all entries on the AKC Web site, www.akc.org and in other AKC publications. Winners will be identified by first name and grade.
- ◆ No faxed entries allowed.
- ◆ Entries will be chosen by qualified judges based on originality, content, quality, and appeal.
- ◆ No purchase necessary to enter or win this contest.
- ◆ The total approximate retail value of the prize to be awarded each first place winner is \$38.90 and each second and third place winner is \$15.95. Prize is not transferable or redeemable for cash. No substitution, transfer or cash equivalent of a prize by a winner is permitted.
