

REGULAR

Novice A CD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Handler must be owner or member of household or immediate family (seeC1,S11)• NOT have HANDLED a dog that has earned a Regular or Preferred Novice, Open or Utility title• Dog - NO CD Title• After earning the CD - OK to enter/show in NA for 60 days; may earn an unlimited # of HSDRC in those 60 days, then enter NB• Once the dog has competed in Open it is no longer eligible to be <u>shown</u> in NA• Dog not allowed to be entered in both NA and NB same show, same day
Novice B CD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• After earning the CD title - OK to compete in NB, at trials where entries have closed, until dog earns a qualifying score in Open OR earns a HSDRC more than 60 days after earning the title; must change entries if not closed• Dog not allowed to be entered in both NA and NB same show, same day
Open A CDX	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Handler must be owner or member of household or immediate family (seeC1,S11)• No OTCH handlers• Dog - CD title required; NO CDX title• After earning the CDX title - OK to enter/compete in OA for 60 days; may earn an unlimited # of HSDRC in those 60 days, then enter OB• Once the dog has been <u>competed</u> in Utility it is no longer eligible to be <u>shown</u> in OA• Dog not allowed to be entered in both OA and OB same show, same day
Open B CDX	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog - CD title required• Dog not allowed to be entered in both OA and OB same show, same day• Dog may compete indefinitely in OB
Utility A UD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Handler must be owner or member of household or immediate family (seeC1,S11)• No OTCH handlers• Dog - CDX title required; No UD title• After earning the UD title - OK to enter/compete in UA for 60 days; may earn an unlimited # of HSDRC in those 60 days, then enter UB• Dog not allowed to be entered in both UA and UB same show, same day
Utility B UD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog - CDX title required• Dog not allowed to be entered in both UA and UB same show, same day• Dog may compete indefinitely in UB
UDX	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog - Entered in OB and UB• Dog must have UD title (must have earned CDX to earn UD)• Dog may compete indefinitely for UDX legs
OTCH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog - UD title required• Points earned from OB and UB; not necessary to be entered in both classes on the same day• Dog may compete indefinitely for OTCH points

PREFERRED

Preferred Novice PN	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog - No CDX or PCDX or higher Regular or Preferred title• OK to be entered in other BNA (if otherwise eligible) until PCD is earned• Once a dog earns a qualifying score in P-Open OR earns a HSDPC more than 60 days after earning the title the dog may be shown in PN in trials for which entries have closed. If entries have not closed they must be changed.
Preferred Open PO	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog – Must have CD or PCD or higher Regular or Preferred Title• Dog may compete indefinitely
Preferred Utility PUTD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog – Must have CDX or PCDX or higher Regular or Preferred Title• Dog may compete indefinitely
PUDX	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog – Must have PUTD to enter (PCDX not required if dog has CDX)• Dog – Must be entered in PO and PU• Dog earns PUDX legs by qualifying in both PO and PU on the same day, same show
POC	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog – Must have PCDX and PUTD title to earn points• Points earned from PO and PU; not necessary to be entered in both classes on the same day• Dog may compete indefinitely for OTCH points

OPTIONAL

Beginner NA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Handler must be owner or member of household or immediate family (see C1,S11)• Dog - No BN title or any other obedience title• After earning the BN title - OK to enter/show in BNA for 60 days, then enter BNB• No dog may be entered in both BNA and BNB
Beginner NB	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any person may handle• Dog – no title, BN, CD or PCD titles ok; no other obedience titles (R,P or O)• No dog may be entered in both BNA and BNB
Grad-Novice	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No restrictions for handlers or dogs
Grad-Open	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No restrictions for handlers or dogs
Versatility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No restrictions for handlers or dogs
