

General Guidelines for Apprentice Tracking Judges

The following guidelines apply to apprentice tracking judges:

- Must have permission of the test secretary or chairman and both officiating judges prior to the test.
- There may only be one apprentice judge per test and only at events where a judging applicant is not being tested.
- At least one judge must be an approved regular status judge and not a member of the apprentice's household or immediate family.
- The apprentice judge must be present on both the day of plotting and the day of the test. A minimum of three tracks must be plotted and judged for the apprenticeship to apply.
- Apprentice judges must follow the instructions of the judges the day of plotting and the
 day of the test. An apprentice judge must never interfere with the activities of the
 judges or in any way delay plotting or judging.
- At the conclusion of the test, the apprentice judge and the officiating regular status judges must briefly discuss the apprentice's charts and the evaluation of each dog's performance during the test. Both officiating judges must sign the apprentice judging form. Completed forms and official charts must accompany the prospective judge's application when applying to become a judge.



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Tracking Apprentice Judging Form

Apprentice judging is for prospective

judges ONLY and can only be done at the level the apprentice is eligible to apply for. This form must be completed, signed by both of the officiating judges, and submitted with an application when applying for approval as a provisional judge. Apprentice must draw own field maps/official charts & submit with this form.
